

New Aftercare Policy

After much consideration, it is necessary to make some changes to the Aftercare payment policy. In the past, parents were not required to pay for a week of Aftercare if their child(ren) did not attend the program that week. This was originally done to make it easier and less expensive for families, however, in doing so, it has become problematic in several ways for the school.

This includes the impact that it has on:


- Personnel, i.e. the number of teachers hired to take care of a certain number of children on a given day.
- Faculty payroll – number of children does impact paying teachers
- Bookkeeping – it has become extremely difficult to determine accuracy regarding attendance.

With this in mind, we are asking families who have children registered in before/after care to pay all weekly fees whether a child is in attendance or not. There are 37 weeks of the Before/After School Program. Parents are not charged for Christmas Week or Easter Week when school is closed.

Please remember that it is important to keep payments current. They may be paid weekly or bi-weekly. I realize that most of you are very good about paying your bills, but for those of you who have a tendency to do everything “tomorrow”, perhaps we can work on becoming more aware of things that should be taken care of today.
